

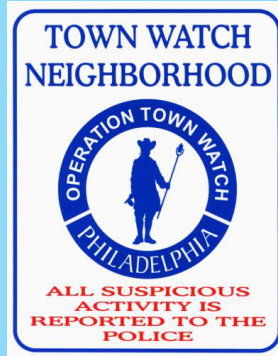
Junior Town Watch

Junior Town Watch is a program designed to involve the youth of our community in the local Town Watch group

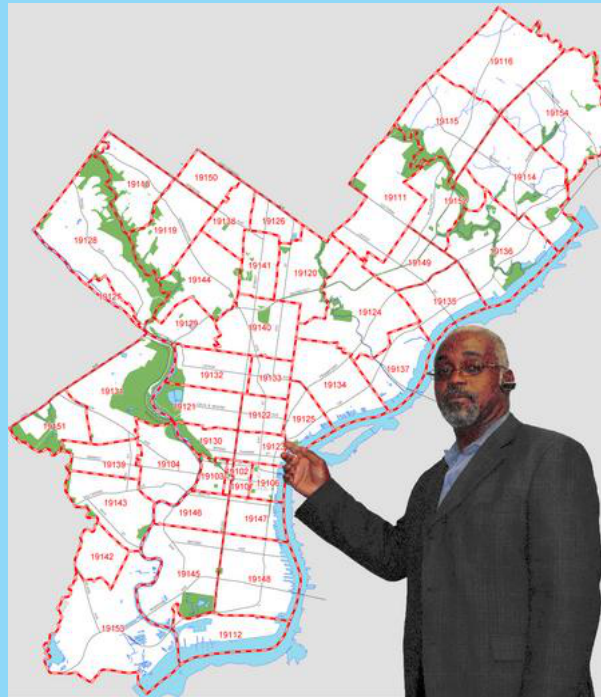
It is a means for youth to become active in community improvement projects and to understand the need for participation in community safety, outreach and education projects.

Junior Town Watch members do not patrol.



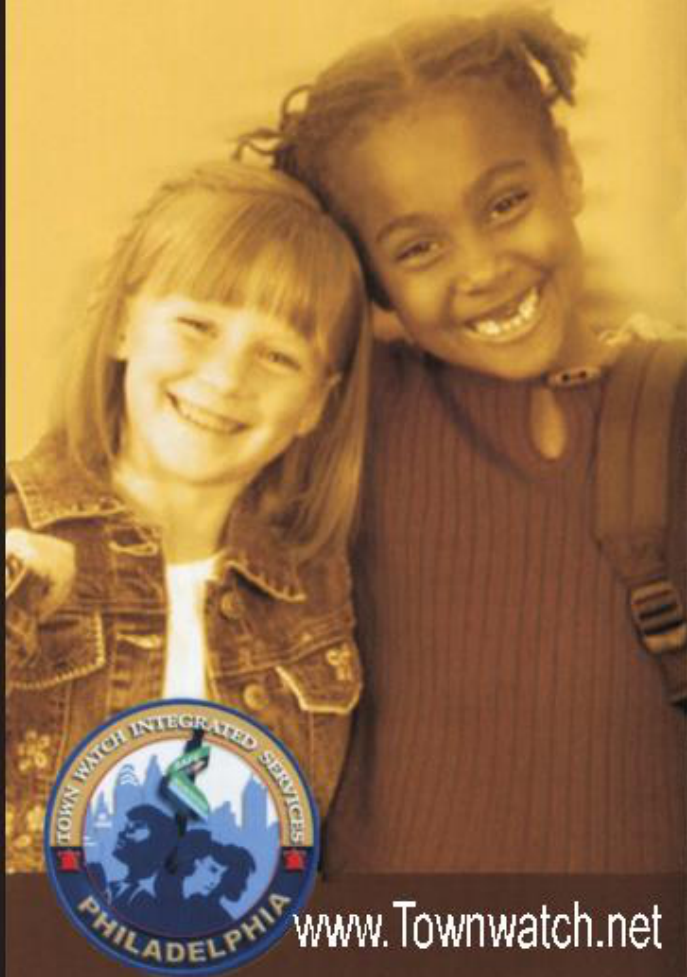
